BEFORE THEY HAPPEN.



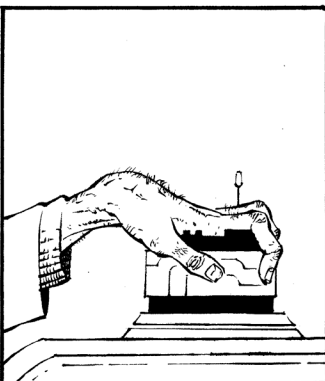

ANOTHER ME!



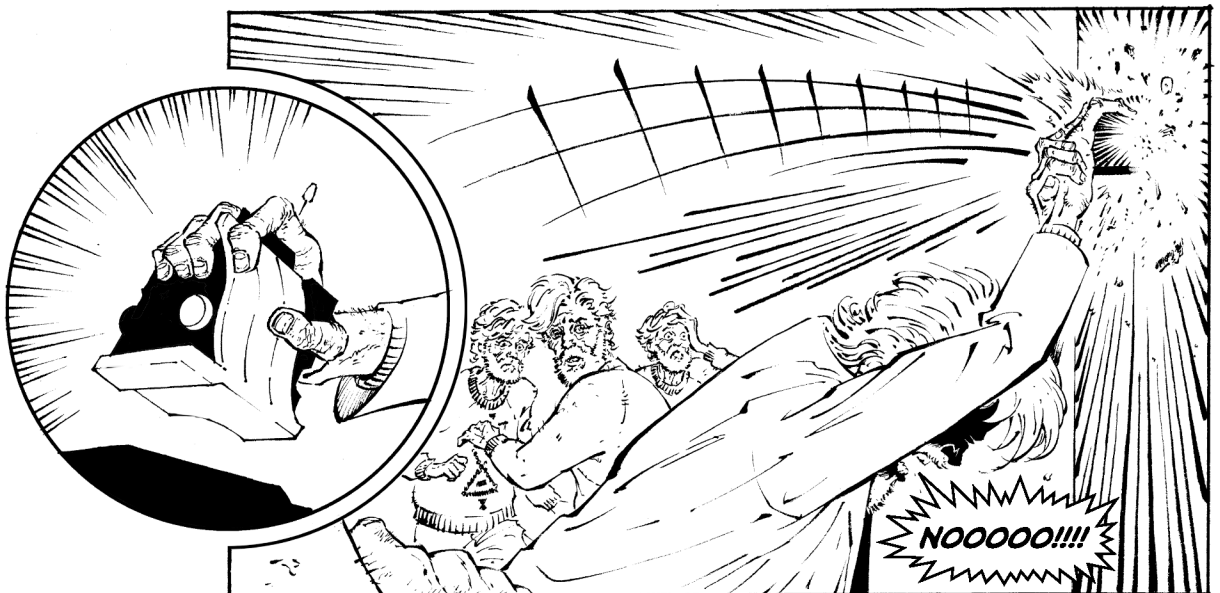
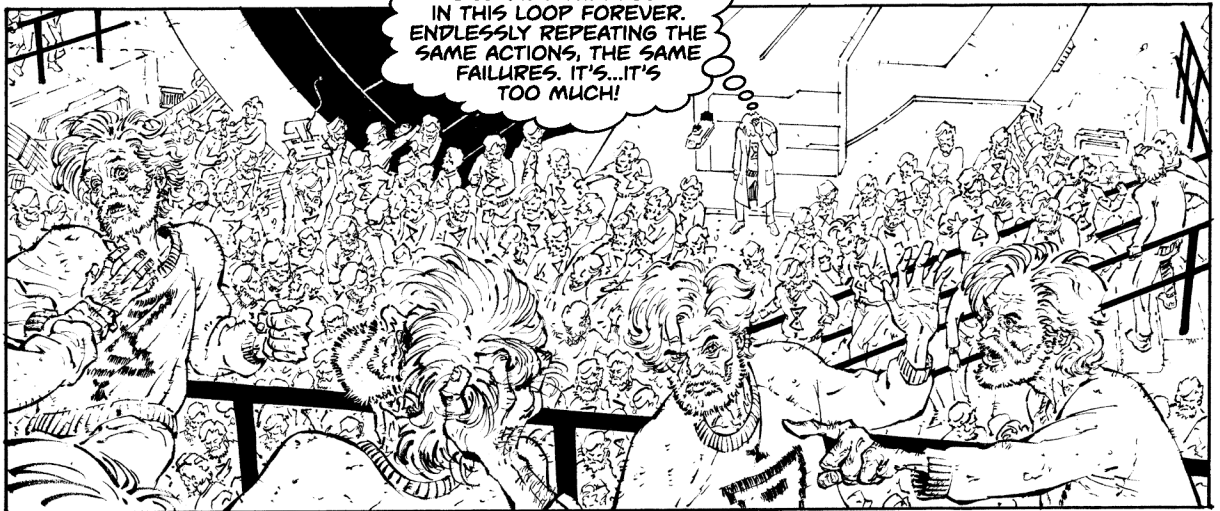
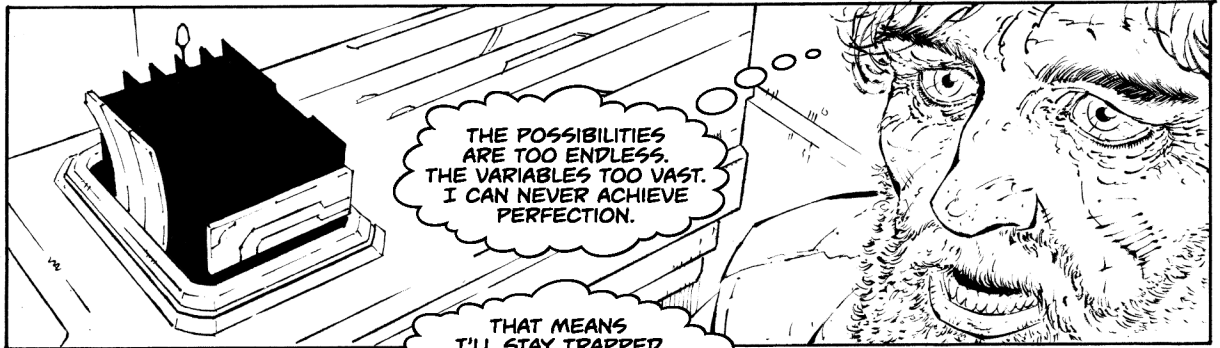

INEFFECTIVE. SHE STILL REJECTS US.









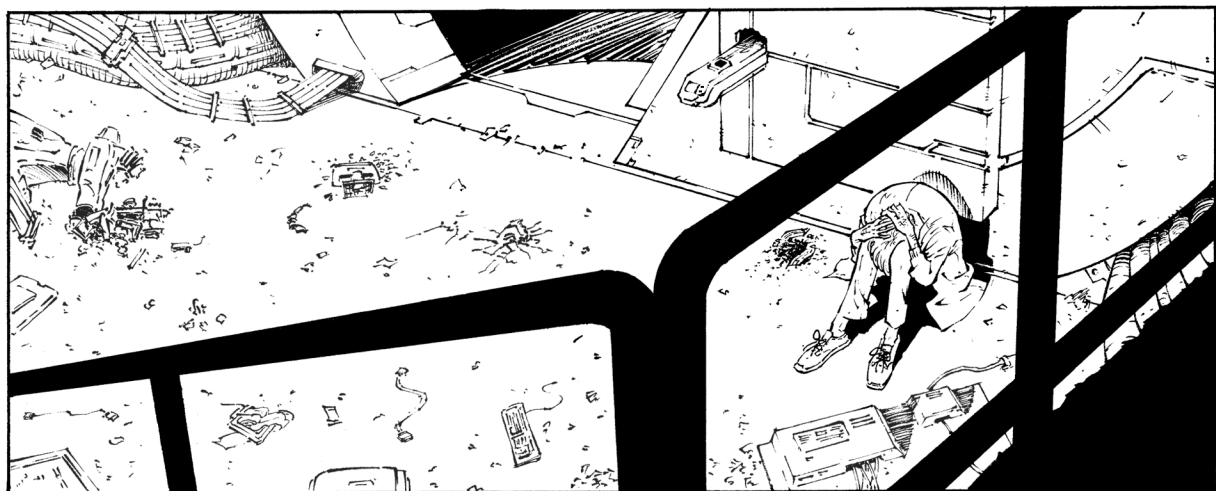
Had we but world enough and time,
