#### Page One, Panel One

- 1) BULLY (OFF-PANEL): What's the matter, Gumbi?
- 2) BULLY (OFF-PANEL): You're looking kinda green.

#### Page One, Panel Two

Trevor punches the Bully across the face. The Bully is another nameless student at the mansion. He, however, is a normal-looking teenage boy.

[NO DIALOGUE]

#### Page One, Panel Three

Trevor stands over the Bully, who is crouching on the ground.

1) TREVOR: And you're looking a little bruised.

#### Page One, Panel Four

Close-up on the Bully. Hate is written all over his face. One of his fists has been brought close to his chin. It's beaming with electricity.

2) BULLY: You're gonna pay for that.

# **PAGE TWO:**

# Page Two, Panel One

The Bully throws a punch, but Trevor dodges it.

3) TREVOR: Too slow.

#### Page Two, Panel Two

Trevor punches the Bully in the stomach.

[NO DIALOGUE]

### Page Two, Panel Three

The Bully is once again on the ground, with Trevor standing over him.

- 4) TREVOR: Had enough?
- 5) SOMEONE'S VOICE (OFF-PANEL): Perhaps he has not...

# Page Two, Panel Four

A strong gust of wind knocks Trevor to the ground.

6) SOMEONE'S VOICE (OFF-PANEL): But I have.

# Page Three, SPLASH

The voice belongs to Storm. She looms over Trevor in this splash page. Her expression is anything but amused.

- 5) CYCLOPS: Fighting is not the answer.

### Page Four, Panel Three

Tighter shot of Trevor and Cyclops.

- 6) TREVOR: You X-Men fight all the time.
- 7) CYCLOPS: We fight to protect the world, not our pride.
- 8) CYCLOPS: One more fight and you're out of here. Understood?

#### Page Four, Panel Four

Trevor is walking out of the office.

9) TREVOR: Whatever.

Close-up on Storm as she watches Trevor leave.

# **PAGE FIVE:**

### Page Five, Panel One
